The Northampton County Parks and Recreation Division will host an evening program with live bats on **Friday, October 25, 5:30PM to 6:30PM** on at Louise W. Moore Park, 146 Country Club Road, Easton, Pavilion. Join Sue Gallagher, Chief Naturalist with the Carbon County Environmental Education Center, for this free program about some of our wildlife neighbors—bats!

Sue will talk about local bats in Eastern Pennsylvania and the hazards they face. She will also speak about bat myths and misconceptions, the importance of bats in ecosystems worldwide, and, most importantly, how to help bats in your community.
