Easy Apple Crisp Recipe

- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup quick cook or old-fashioned oats
- 1/3 cup butter or margarine, softened
- 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 3/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- Whipped Cream or ice cream optional

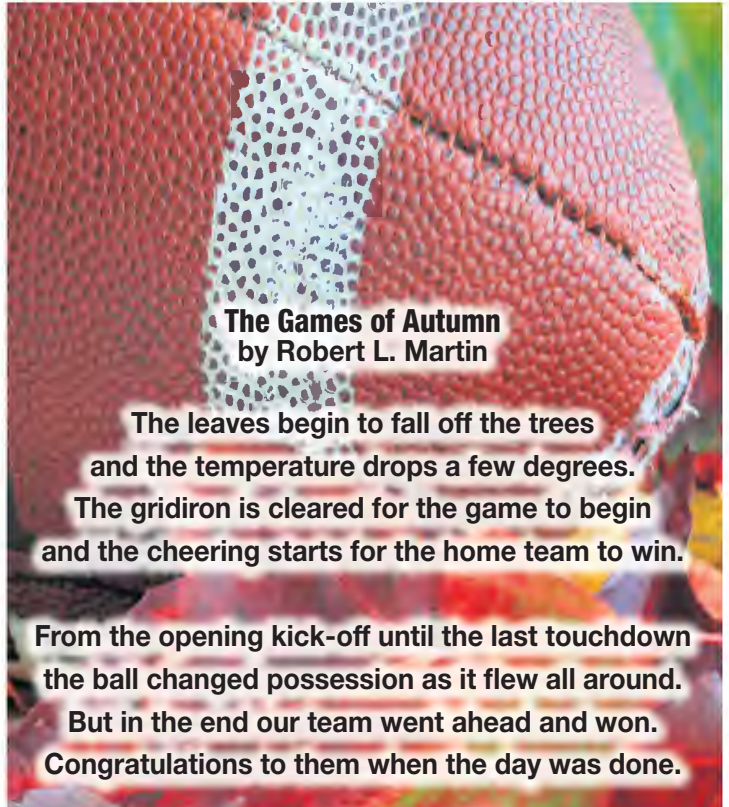
