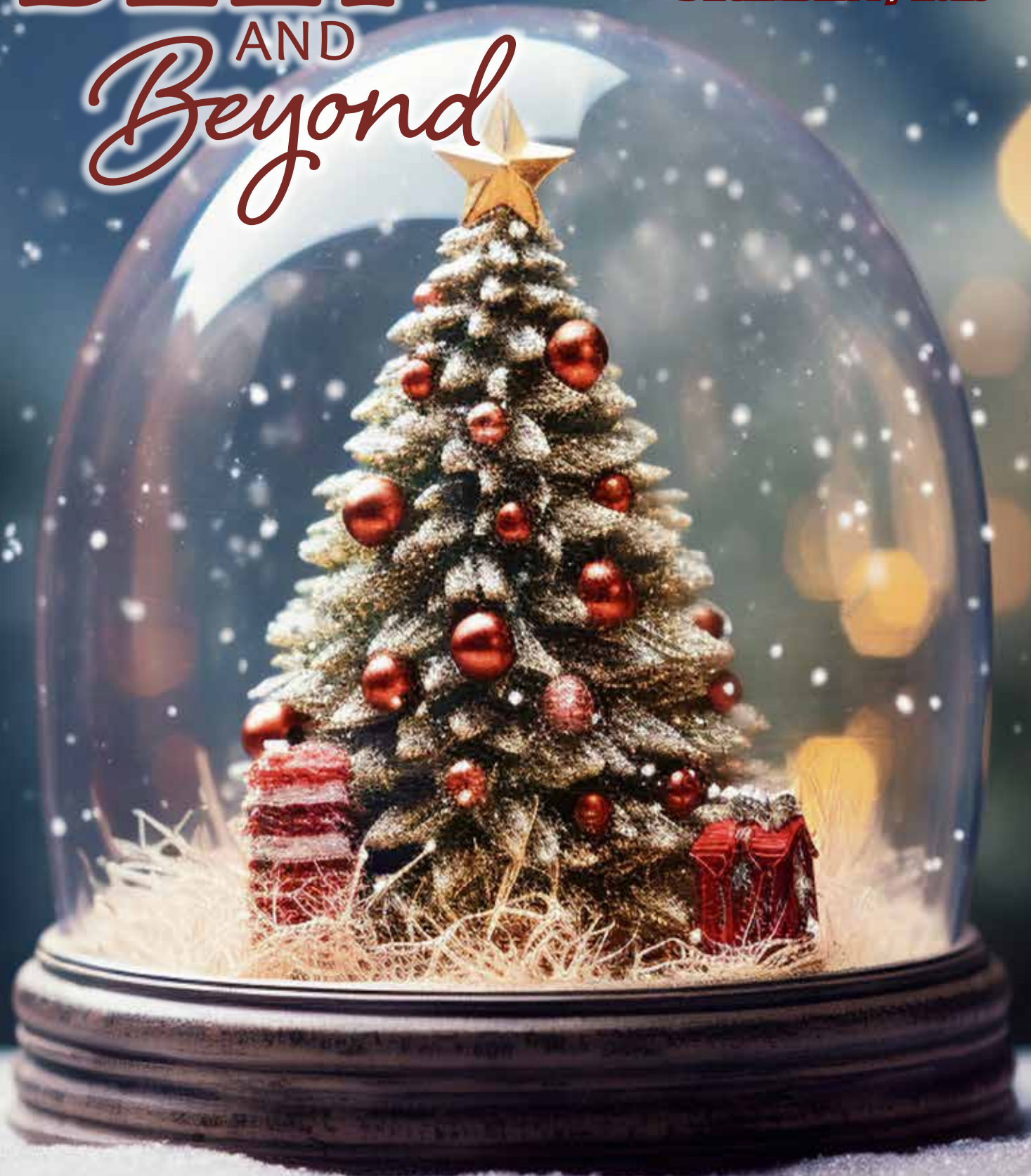

Pen Argyl Area High School Unruffs the Bus

On Friday November 17th students from the Pen Argyl High School went to the YMCA to sort, count, package, and hand out all the food that was collected from the huge Stuff the Bus event. 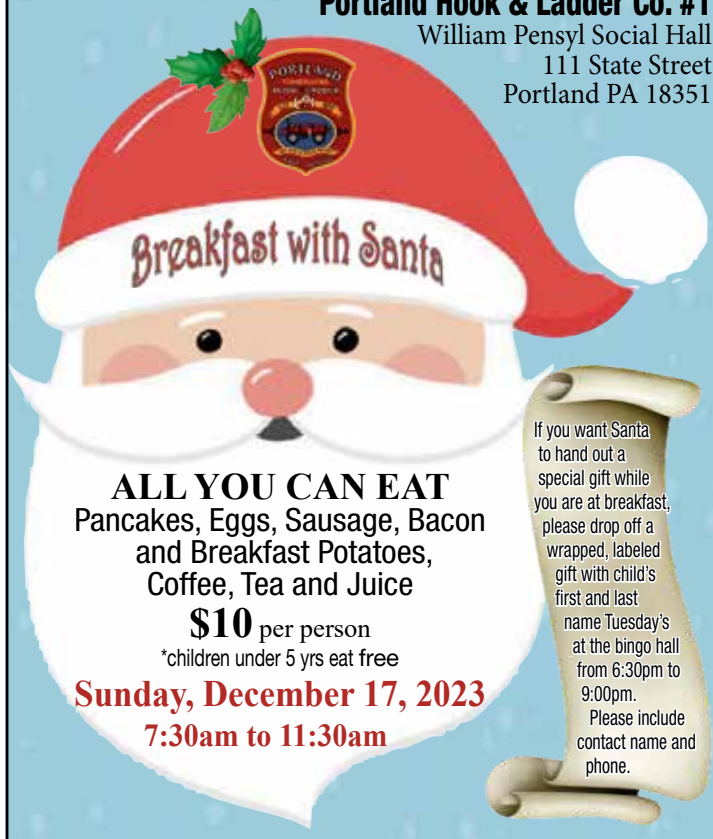
