Rockfall Harming our Communities

Since December 2022, State Route 611 has been closed between Northampton and Monroe counties along the Delaware Water Gap portion of the roadway due to dangerous rock fall.

Being the second such closure over the past two years, our community and local businesses have been struggling. Local business owners have struggled to keep their doors open due to ongoing detours and the steady decline of visitors, which has ultimately resulted in the loss of employment. Many residents have found themselves needing to pay tolls just to go to the grocery store or to doctors' appointments due to the detours caused by the closure.

I have been working with multiple offices and government agencies for answers from day one and I am finally able to report on the status of the repairs. Christopher Kufro, district director from PennDOT; Portland Borough Mayor Heather Fischer; Upper Mt. Bethel Township Manager Ed Nelson; House Transportation Committee Majority Chairman Ed Neilson (D-Philadelphia) and Minority Chairman Kerry Benninghoff (R-Centre) joined us for an on-site meeting along the affected area.

We walked the mile-long stretch and viewed up-close the deterioration of the crumbling rock-faced walls that were falling onto the roadway. After months of speculation and unanswered questions, the depth and complexity of the project in detail was shared with us by PennDOT officials. Mr. Kufro explained that PennDOT has supplied the U.S. National Park Service (NPS) with all documentation required for the permit. He detailed the struggles of getting the cooperation from NPS on issuing the numerous permits necessary to keep the project moving.

The project will be done in multiple phases, the first and shortest involves the scaling of the rock face walls to remove the loose material. The detailed manner to complete this task is done by hand and with precision to maintain the integrity of the remaining wall. Once all permitting is secured from the federal agencies, and Phase One is complete, it is the hope that at minimum a single lane can safely be opened.

Throughout the project, all the departments will be working simultaneously to be certain that everything is examined meticulously as numerous fossils have been discovered in the past throughout the area. Phase Two would be the placement of a coated mesh in a localized section to hold back the remaining rocks. This specially coated mesh is anchored into the mountainside and along the shoulder area. If I receive any further details, I will be certain to share them immediately. Thank you to everyone who has worked with me and my office to ensure our residents stay up to date on this issue.


