20th Annual West End Pink Light Walk

This year's West End Pink Light Walk was held on Tuesday October 10th and drew a crowd of well over 200 people from West End and neighboring areas. Survivors were donned in hot pink, while their friends, family, and caregivers were in light pink; all gathered at the American Legion to prepare for a walk near the West End Fairgrounds whilst being accompanied by the Lehigh Valley Chapter of Pink Heals. The night began with laughter, happiness and friendships that have formed over the years between friends and community members with raffle tickets being sold for various gift baskets that were donated and volunteers handing out flashlights for the upcoming event walk. Booths along the perimeter of the hall engaged people with various shirts, information, specialized wares and an overwhelming level of support to all those who attended, whether it being their first time participating or 20th. Jeni Hacket provided entertainment while more people filled the hall.

At 6:30pm, community members gathered in the parking lot and briefly stretched before being led down Fairgrounds Lane, with an escort from the local fire department leading the way and the Pink Heals ambulance bringing up the tail end of the parade. During their trek down the road, people talked, laughed, and shared stories both inspiring and heartbreaking of personal experiences and memories of those that were no longer with them. At the heart of the walk, everyone gathered around an area with pink flags set up to honor those who are fighting, have beaten, or those who succumbed to breast cancer. Survivors shouted out how long they've been cancer free to rally those who may have recently been diagnosed to empower their peers that cancer isn't something unbeatable, and support within the community does exist.

The flashlight lit walk back to the American Legion was filled with laughter, tears and new friendships being made. Once refreshments had been served and people filled the seats again, speakers from American Cancer Society. Breast Friends of Pennsylvania, Relay for Life, Perfect Balance, PA Breast Cancer Coalition, and St. Luke's Hospital all offering various forms of information, support, and reassurance that no matter what you are going through, you are not alone.


