





**Senior Farmers Market Coupons Available for Northampton County Residents** 


Lamont McClure is pleased to announce the continuation of the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. In June, coupons worth \$20.00 will be available to Northampton County residents age 60 and over who meet the income eligibility criteria. The coupons are distributed by the Northampton County Area Agency on Aging Department. The \$20 coupon can be used to purchase food at farmer's markets. Any Northampton County resident age 60 or over who meets income eligibility (example: \$23,107/yr. for a single person in 2019, and \$31,284 for a couple) can obtain a coupon. For married couples, both spouses may obtain coupons. Proof of age and residence must be presented by all persons wishing to receive coupons. Program policies allow a person to obtain coupons for another person only if they have a completed and signed proxy form. A person may only serve as proxy for up to four other participants. Identification with date of birth and address, of the older adult, must be shown when presenting a proxy.

The form will be available for pick-up at the AAA office, 2801 Emrick Boulevard, Bethlehem, all senior centers, and will also be available on the AAA's website,

www.northamptoncounty.org. Persons may only receive coupons once during the program, which runs from June 3, 2019 until September 26, 2019.



Extensive scientific research, as well as patient and physician accounts, highlight CBD's potential to treat autoimmune diseases, neurological conditions such as Alzheimer's and Parkinson's, metabolic syndrome, neuropsychiatric illness, gut disorders, cardiovascular dysfunction, and skin disease. In addition, "CBD has proven neuroprotective effects and its anti-cancer properties are being investigated at several research centers in the [US] and elsewhere."

After witnessing his mother's struggle with the effects of addictive pain medications for a decade, Brown began selling CBD products at a farm stand in NJ.

"The proof is in all the people who come back," Brown said. "The stories they tell me are so motivational. I tear up sometimes! They are getting off these pills that are killing them from the inside out."
